

Board of Mayor and Aldermen Meeting
Monday, October 21, 2013
Municipal Building - Court Room

- (1) **Call to Order:** The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, October 21, 2013; in the Municipal Building Court Room at 7:00 p.m. Mayor John Holden presided. The meeting opened with prayer by Alderman Bart Williams. Mayor Holden noted all Aldermen were present.
- (2) **Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of the October 7, 2013 meeting were approved on a motion by Alderman Bart Williams, followed by a second from Alderwoman Jewell Horner. The motion passed approving the minutes.
- (3) **Unfinished Business:** There was no unfinished business.
- (4) **New Business:**

a. Attorney Invoice.

Mayor Holden presented an invoice from the City Attorney's office to be approved for payment. The September 1, 2013 through September 30, 2013 totaling \$9,768.75 was presented. Alderman Bart Williams made a motion to approve the payment, with a second by Alderman Bob Kirk. The motion passed by full Board approval.

b. Bids – Greg Williams, Purchasing Agent.

No bids were presented.

Report from Alderman and Alderwomen:

Alderman Bob Kirk: Complimented Street Department for the house demolition on McGaughey Street.

Alderman Bart Williams: reported various citizen complaints and his personal observations. These included: Horner Road remains the only unpaved road in the City, and potentially placing a street traffic at this location, because there is no stop sign at the intersection of Horner Road into South Main Avenue, and that an individual is lodging under the bridge on South Main Avenue. Mayor Holden noted that it would be reported to the police department for them to investigate.

Alderman Jewell Horner: Reminded the public of the upcoming Special Olympics Bowling events in November 2013.

Alderman Dennis Moody: Offered a courtesy reminder for the City's annual leaf removal service that will run from November to January 2014.

Alderman Robert Taylor, Jr.: Offered a thank you to the Street Department for their clean-up on upper Finley Road.

Communications from the Mayor:

- Gave an update to several recent critical Dyersburg Police responses. Mayor Holden paid tribute to the professional and expedient responses of the Department.
