

BOARD MINUTES
Tuesday, January 9, 1872
Court House

The Mayor and Aldermen met at the Court House. Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Deberry, Miller, McAllister, Roberts and Sampson.

On motion Aldermen Miller and McAllister were appointed a committee to settle with the Recorder and Treasurer and Town Marshal for the year 1871.

On motion Alderman Deberry was appointed Street Commissioner and authorized to draw on the Treasurer to pay for work on the streets. And he was instructed to lay down another foot log extending northward from the Court yard.

On motion it was ordered that E.G. Sugg be employed to survey and mark out the lots in Town and drive a stake at every corner of every lot.

On motion Aldermen Deberry, McAllister and Pinner were appointed a committee to recommend a plan for a plank walk to the Female Academy and with the Mayor's consent do the work.

Aldermen J.E. Roberts, G.D. McAllister and J.C. Pinner were fined one dollar each for absence.

On motion J.T. Dalton was appointed Fire Warden and allowed \$5.00 per day for inspections.

On motion it was ordained by the Board that any person refusing to heed and obey the instructions of the Fire Warden be fined by the Mayor at his discretion.

On motion the regular time for the meetings of the Mayor and Aldermen was changed to the second Thursday night in every month.

On motion the Board adjourned.
