

**BOARD MEETING**  
**Thursday, April 4, 1872**  
**Court House**

**The Mayor and Aldermen met at the Court House. Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Miller, McAllister, Pinner and Sampson, and Marshal Nichols.**

**The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.**

**On motion the Mayor and Aldermen by unanimous vote endorsed the Petition of the citizens of Dyersburg and vicinity asking the Congress of the United States to appropriate \$100,000.00 for the improvement of the Forked Deer River and directed copies thereof to be forwarded to the Memphis Chamber of Commerce and to Hon. Robert P. Caldwell.**

**On motion the account of Thomas Mullins for \$4.88 for labor on the Town Survey was allowed.**

**On motion the question of adopting E.G. Sugg's last survey of the Original Town of Dyersburg as definitely settling the boundaries of all the lots, streets and alleys, was postponed and made the special order for the next meeting of this Board.**

**On motion of F.G. Sampson for \$10.50 paid by him for a Mayor's Docket was allowed.**

**On motion F.G. Sampson was allowed \$1.25 paid by him for Corporation Tax Book for 1872.**

**On motion the Board adjourned.**
