

**BORD MEETING  
OCTOBER 20, 1873  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met this evening, Monday the 20<sup>th</sup> of October 1873 at the Court House – at the call of the Mayor.**

**Present Mayor Pinner, Aldermen Coker, Sugg, Sampson and Doyle and Marshal Nichols.**

**On motion the sum of Forty Dollars amount paid by him to Henry Earl, George Crutchfield, J. S. Perry and Lou Southern for work on streets to date, was allowed and ordered to be paid to John M. Nichols – all the Aldermen present voting for the same.**

**On motion, in view of the fact, that the Dyer County fair opens here tomorrow, it is ordered that John M. Nichols the Town Marshal be and he is hereby authorized and directed to employ two policemen to serve under him during the Fair – and that said policemen when selected by him, shall be duly sworn before entering upon their duties by the Mayor.**
