

**BOARD MEETING
November 12, 1873
Court House**

Be it remembered that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met this Wednesday evening, November 12, 1873 at the Court House in Dyersburg pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Pinner, Aldermen Coker, DeBerry, McAllister, Sampson, Sugg and Doyle.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The merchants, to wit: T. S. Chamblin, W.H. Simpson, N. C. White, I. F. Child, R. R. Watson, W.E. DeBerry, E. G. Sugg, C. L. Nolen, John L. Webb & W. D. Roberts being present, after consultation among them and the Aldermen, the merchants present declared their belief that the assessment heretofore made upon merchandise was and is legal and they asked only for further time. Thereupon, on motion It is ordered that the Recorder and Marshal suspend the collection of the Rail Road Tax until the 10th of December next.

An account for \$3.87 for building a bridge was presented to D. C. Hibbett and the same referred to the committee on accounts with instructions to report at the next meeting.

On motion the Board adjourned.
