

**BOARD MEETING
February 5, 1874
Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met in regular meeting this 1st Thursday evening, February 5, 1874 at the Court House.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen DeBerry, Roberts, Wilson, Thurman and White and Marshall Nichols.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion the Board proceeded to ballot for an Alderman to fill vacancy caused by the death of Alderman Stevens, wherefrom F. G. Sampson, Esquire was declared duly elected, he appeared before the Board, was duly sworn by the Mayor and took his seat as Alderman.

The committee to inspect Bridge at warehouse appointed by a former meeting, failing to make a report, Aldermen DeBerry, Wilson and Thurman for repairs at next meeting.

A standing committee was appointed to make the assessment for 1874, Aldermen Sampson, Wilson, DeBerry Committee, and are to report at next meeting.

An account was presented by Henry Earl for \$19.00 for work on plank walk and ordered to be paid.

On motion Marshall Nichols was ordered to confer with Henry Earl and ascertain what his services can be had for to work balance of this year on streets.

On motion it was ordered that the Board witness the location of R.Road Depot on tomorrow morning.

On motion Board adjourned.
