

BOARD MEETING
May 7, 1877
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 7th day May 1877.

Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Thurmond, Scott, Miller & White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The committee on alley west of Church Street made a verbal report to the effect that in their opinion said alley should be opened.

On motion the above report was ordered to be received and committee discharged.

When on motion it was ordered that the parties owning property on the alley west of Church Street, be and are hereby required to open said alley as far as Cedar Street.

On motion it was ordained that the barbers of the Town of Dyersburg be and are hereby required to close their shops on the Sabbath day and they are to do no shaving on that day.

On motion it was ordained that it shall be considered an offense for any person or persons to sell spirituous or malt liquors, wine or cider on the Sabbath day within the limits of this Corporation except druggist who are only allowed to sell to parties having a physicians certificate. Any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be arrested by the Marshal and brought before the Mayor to be fined not less than Five dollars (\$5.00) or more than Twenty Five dollars (\$25.00).

On motion an account in favor of G. B. Miller for Fifteen 40/100 Dollars (\$15.40) was allowed.

On motion Board adjourned.
