

BOARD MEETING

July 24, 1878

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at the Court House this the 24th day of July 1878 on call of the Mayor.

Present Mayor Clark, Aldermen Miller, Nichols, Scott, Sawyers, Parr & White and Marshal Ferguson.

The Mayor explained the object of the meeting to be for the purpose of deciding whether Mr. Jno. Biesser shall be required to move his store house off of the pavement or not.

When on motion of Alderman Scott it was ordered that Mr. Jno. Bisser be and is hereby required to move his store building on north side of the square back on the line of the street.

On motion of Alderman Miller it was ordered that the gutter carrying the water off of the Stevens store house into the street (next to Sawyers Hall) is hereby declared a nuisance and the Marshal is ordered to have it abated.

On motion a committee was appointed to examine into the question and the propriety of building a plank walk from McGaughey Street up Troy Street to George Scott's line. Aldermen Nichols and Sawyers committee and are to report at our next regular meeting.

On motion Board adjourned.
