

BOARD MEETING
June 6, 1881
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 6th day of June 1881.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen A. M. Stevens, Ed Smith, C. L. Nolen, H. Parks, Jr., and N. C. White and Marshal Nichols.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that a committee be appointed to examine the dog-trot walks to ascertain if further work is necessary to make said walk permanent. Committee to report at next meeting. Alderman Smith appointed committeeman on walk running east, Alderman Nichols appointed on walks running west.

The committee on plank walks submitted a written report on the amount of lumber used and cost of same, which report on motion was ordered received, the committee discharged and report filed. (No. A)

On motion it was ordered that a warrant for One hundred and thirty two 45/100 dollars be issued in favor of A. M. Stevens for balance due him on lumber furnished for plank walks.

On motion it was ordered that a committee be appointed to have a four-foot plank walk constructed from the cemetery walk to the Baptist Church, committee Aldermen Parks and Nolen.

On motion an account in favor of Alderman Smith for amount paid Hagnewood and Walker for constructing hand railing on plank walk (amt. to each \$1.50) making \$3.00 in full was allowed.

On motion an account in favor of W. Turner for repairing culvert account \$2.25 was allowed and warrant ordered issued and to be turned over to the Marshal with another warrant due said Turner to be used by the Marshal in his settlement with Mr. Turner.

On motion it was ordered that the recorder be permitted to issue licenses for less than a year in accordance with the state law, providing the parties taking out license for less than one year pay the clerks fee of .50 for same. All licenses issued under the above order to expire on or before the 1st day November 1881.

On motion Board adjourned.
