

BOARD MEETING
December 4, 1882
Court House

Board of Mayor and Aldermen met at the Court House in regular session for Town of Dyersburg December 4, 1882.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Jno. W. Nichols, A. B. Jones, W. E. DeBerry, Ed Smith and W. R. Hayes and Marshal Nichols.

Minutes of last meeting read and signed.

On motion Mayor was instructed to take steps to collect rent due Corporation from Herman Tinkle.

On motion committee on walk allowed further time to report.

On motion lumber and nails allowed to run walk from King corner to jail – parties on that street putting down and on motion committee of investigation in regard to Sugg lot allowed further time. On motion account J. T. Freeman Jailer \$22.40 allowed and ordered showed on Mayor's Docket.

On motion account Parr Nolen eleven & 20/100 allowed. On motion account Z. W. Watkins tax list for 1882 Twelve & 50/100 dollars allowed.

On motion account all stores was referred to A. B. Jones and Ed Smith, committee, to correct before warrant was issued.

On motion following committee was appointed to settle with Recorder and Treasurer to wit: Jno Nichols, Ed Smith, A. B. Jones.

On motion following committee was appointed to settle with Marshall to wit: W. R. Hayes, Ed Smith and A. B. Jones. Both committees assisted by F. G. Sampson.

On motion Recorder was instructed to draw up a petition signed by Mayor and Aldermen to C & W R.R. for gravel to put on street running to depot. On motion Jno. W. Nichols and A. B. Jones appointed to get 5 stone lamps and have same put up on street leading to the depot.

On motion Board adjourned till meeting in January 1883.
