

**BOARD MEETING
April 3, 1883
Court House**

Be it remembered that a stated meeting of Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg was held in Court House on Tuesday night April 3, 1883.

Present Mayor Thomas, Aldermen A. B. Jones, Z. G. Watkins, J. W. Baker, Ed Smith and W. R. Hayes and Marshall Thurmond.

Minutes of last meeting read and signed.

On motion report of the committee on the Calaboose was read and discharged and report ordered filed with papers.

On motion committee on walks allowed further time.

On motion committee to settle with J. W. Nichols allowed further time.

On motion account in favor R. A. Burke for three & 50/100 dollars allowed.

On motion account of Latta & Marshall was referred to same committee as before to make best settlement possible.

On motion Corporation privilege tax on butchers was repealed.

On motion Marshall was instructed to see that the slop and filth from privy is not run through the sewer leading from Tucker's Hotel.

On motion livery stables and blacksmith shops were allowed ten feet in front of their doors and one dollar to be collected from them if they occupy more than the 10 feet allowed, with buggies, wagons,????????????????????

On motion Board adjourned.
