August 6, 1884

Regular meeting of Board of Mayor and Aldermen was held in the Court House on August 6, 1884.

Present Mayor Thomas, Aldermen Watkins, Jones, Smith, Pinner, Baker, Hayes and Marshall Thurmond.

Minutes of last meeting read, approved and signed.

On motion Board endorsed the action and recommendations of the Board of Health and Mayor Thomas was appointed to carry out this suggestion in regard to sanitary regulations.
