

**BOARD MEETING**  
**February 2, 1885**  
**Court House**

Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met in regular session at Court House on Monday night February 2, 1885. Present Mayor Thomas and Aldermen Smith, Watkins, Jones, Turner, Tenney, Hayes and Marshall Thurmond.

Minutes of last meeting read, approved and signed.

On motion the ordinance in regard to the collection of Corporation Taxes was ordered to be enforced and the Marshal was instructed to publish. Motion that all parties not paying their taxes by 20<sup>th</sup> day of February would be proceeded against by the law to collect same.

On motion following accounts were allowed:

On motion it was ordered continued on Depot Street to the Depot the county paying one half of cost of same.

On motion Wm Turner was appointed a committee to have walk continued from Mrs. Sampson's corner to alley north of Dr. Arnold's residence.

On motion Ed Smith and Wm. Turner were appointed committee to examine the walk running east of Sugg Hotel and report what the conditions of it was and what aught to be done to it.
