August 3, 1885
Court House

Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met at Court House on Monday night August 3, 1885 in regular session.

Present Mayor Thomas, Aldermen Jones, Smith, Watkins, Turner, Tenney and Hayes and Marshal J. P. Thurmond.

Minutes of last meetings read, approved and signed.

On motion committee on walk to Beach Grove allowed further time.

On motion the committee on tiling was continued.

On motion a committee on ways and means was appointed to act with any other committee in getting up a barbecue for giving a reception to the excursion party that will probably be in Dyersburg in September or October – Watkins, Jones, Tenney, Thurmond and Hayes.

On motion the Mayor was instructed to contract for having the levy east of Sugg's Hotel made broader and wider provided he could do so on reasonable times and the Corporation finances will justify.

On motion following accounts allowed:
