**November 7, 1887**

On motion Wm. Turner was called to the chair.

Minutes of last meeting read, approved.

On motion committee on A. M. Stevens lease continued – Hayes and Smith.

On motion committee on Fowlkes and Miller Street discharged they not deeming it necessary to put down walk.

On motion committee was appointed to have walk put down on Fowlkes Street if necessary in their judgments – Jones, Brackin and Marshal.
