

**BOARD MEETING
December 5, 1887**

Be it remembered that on Monday night, December 5, 1887, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Dyersburg met in regular session.

Present and presiding Mayor Thomas, Aldermen J. M. Brackin, G. B. Miller, A. B. Jones, Wm. Turner and W. R. Hayes – Marshal E. L. Smith.

Minutes of last meeting read, approved and signed.

On motion committee on walk on Fowlkes Street continued.

On motion A. M. Stevens lease on saw mill lot was extended ten years and following committee appointed to have necessary papers drawn up, to-wit: Miller, Jones and Hayes.

On motion Marshal Smith was instructed to have the walk from Wilson's corner to Fowler Woods repaired.

On motion a committee to-wit: Turner and Jones was appointed to make report in regard to a walk from ? Hotel running west, and if not, to expression to have same built.

On motion W. M. King was allowed a tax receipt for thirty dollars for putting brick walk in front of his store house.

On motion following accounts were allowed:

On motion Recorder was instructed to send ? Neill two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) dollars attorney's fee in part on Rail Road vs. Corporation.

On motion Marshal's report was read and following committees appointed, to-wit: to settle with Recorder, Jones Smith and Brackin to settle with Marshal, Jones, Smith and Hayes for year 1887.

On motion committee was appointed to have the pond made by building switch (on north side) drained, said pond being declared a nuisance – Brackin and Jones.

No further business appearing Board adjourned.
