

Minutes of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen
City of Dyersburg
May 4, 2009

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, May 4, 2009 in the municipal courtroom at 7 p.m.

Mayor John Holden presided with all Aldermen present.

The meeting opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag" followed by prayer by Alderman Freeman Dudley.

The minutes of the April 20, 2009 meeting were approved as written on a motion by Aldermen Norman and Kirk.

Power Board Appointment

On a motion by Aldermen Kirk and Walker, Mr. David Hayes was appointed to the Dyersburg Electric System Power Board for the term of July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2009.

Railroad Repair

Mayor Holden reported that the Board's authorization to proceed at the April 20 meeting resulted in a railroad repair bids of \$29,450 less that the estimate of \$54,000.

Finance/Street Committee Reports

Finance Chairman Lewis Norman reported on the joint committee meeting of April 22 and April 27, 2009.

The proposed Property Maintenance Code was revised during the April 22 meeting. The proposed code compiles all existing property codes into one municipal code title and chapter. It updates the ordinances to comply with current TCA.

The April 27 meeting was a review of the \$22,850,000 proposed 2009-2010 budget for the Dyersburg City Schools. The committees recommended adoption of the budget.

Resolution #050409 Municipal Technical Advisory Service commended for 60 years of service

On a motion by Aldermen Dudley and McCright, the Board recognized MTAS for 60 years of service to Tennessee's cities.

Reports

Alderman Williams recognized Will Armstrong of Troop 88, who attended the meeting as part of his Eagle Scout program.

Alderman Dudley reminded everyone to attend the Bluegrass Festival on May 15-16.

Alderman Moody expressed concern about skateboarders on the streets and without helmets at the skateboard park.

Alderman Norman inquired about any need for Board action on Department of Justice grants.

Alderman McCright asked that the house on Central at Harton Row be cleaned up.

Mayor Holden announced the Mayors Prayer Breakfast for 6 a.m. May 7th at First Baptist Church. He stated that the Finance Committee would meet to discuss adoption of the state mandated fire and building codes.

Budget – Dyersburg City Schools 2009-2010

School Board member Gleyn Twilla presented the Dyersburg City Schools budget for 2009-2010. The \$22,850,000 budget was approved on a motion by Aldermen Norman and Moody.

The meeting adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
