

Minutes of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen
City of Dyersburg
November 1, 2010

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, November 1, 2010 in the municipal courtroom at 7 p.m.

Mayor John Holden presided with all aldermen present except Aldermen Charles McCright.

The meeting opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag" followed by prayer by Alderman Lewis Norman.

Minutes of the October 18, 2010 meeting were approved on a motion by Aldermen Williams and Horner.

Public Hearing- Beer Permit-Dollar General Store #7250

Police Chief Art Heun stated that the applicants meet all of the requirements set forth in the ordinance. On a motion by Aldermen Kirk and Chaney, an on premises beer permit was granted to Dollar General Store #7250 at 1478 US Highway 51 Bypass East with permit holder Wendell P. Robbins.

Liquor Store Certificate of Compliance

Police Chief Heun stated that Mr. Burton Andrew Chandler and the location of the City Liquors, Inc. at 2410 Lake Road Suite H meets all of the requirements set forth in City ordinances. On a motion by Aldermen Kirk and Dudley, the Board approved the issue of a Certificate of Compliance to be sent to the Tennessee Alcohol and Beverage Commission.

Finance/ Water& Sewer Committee

Finance Chairman Lewis Norman reported on the meeting of November 1, 2010. The joint committees had addressed an insurance claim against the City. Information about a sewer line backup was provided by property owners Dennis/Jenny Watts and by TML adjuster Dennis Dalton. After a third party investigation, TML had determined that the City had no legal obligation since there had been no prior notice and no overt actions by the City caused any damage. The Committee had asked TML to do another review of the situation.

Mr. Dennis Watts thanked the Board for all of the City's efforts and the help of all of the City officials.
