The Dyersburg Municipal-Regional Planning Commission met in regular session on Thursday, February 11, 2010 in the municipal courtroom at 10:10 a.m.

Members present: All except Commissioners Burks, Dudley and Guthrie

Vice-Chairman Paul Newbill presided. The minutes of the two meeting on January 14, 2010, were approved on a motion by Commissioners Dement and Haymon.

Review: Zoning Map and Land Use Map

State Planner Kim Morgan presented a copy of the 2020 Development Plan and the goals and policies adopted with the plan, so they could be used as a guide in reviewing the Zoning Map.

Ms. Morgan gave a brief overview of the current zoning map. She commended Pam Pleasant and Carmen Cupples of the GIS Department for all of their research into the discrepancies between the City GIS map and the map being maintained by LPO.

At a future meeting, the Commission will be given a proposed Zoning Map to be reviewed, amended and recommended to the City Board for adoption.

Reports

Mayor Holden reported on the City's efforts to prepare for the 2010 Census. He stressed the need for a full count to ensure the City get its fair share of federal and state funding. City Staff, City Schools and other agencies are working to make the Census a success.
